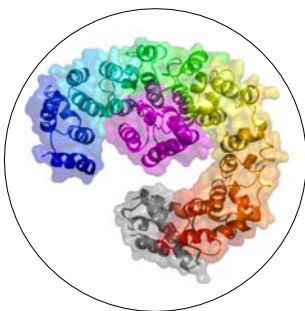
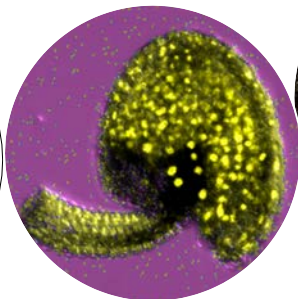
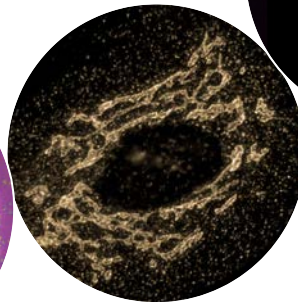
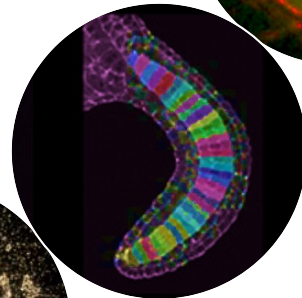
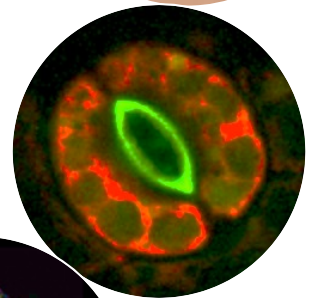


Graduate Studies in Molecular, Cellular & Developmental Biology
